

Some of the World's Worst: Based Right In Florida

Florida's economy is booming. It continues to be a national leader in job growth and it continues to have one of the lowest unemployment rates in the country. However, Florida is also home to a host of companies which are some of the world's worst. For example, RKNetmedia, Inc. and Ox Ideas are based out of Miami and are two of the largest producers of internet pornography on the planet. (Note: I will not write the names of the sites they produce due to their graphic content.) They produce some of the most viewed pornographic sites on the net and have earned millions of dollars doing so. They are part of a growing internet exploitation problem in Florida. The St. Petersburg Times notes in a November 23, 2006 article that Florida law prohibits the "use of computers to transmit images, information, data that is harmful to minors." (Because a minor viewing two adults engaged in sex is clearly going to be harmed by those images). So any company that transmits those images is clearly violating Florida law.

My hope and prayer is that we can lobby our legislators and work with Florida's law enforcement to strike a major blow to those who harm our children through the internet images they produce.
