What Kind of Soldier Am I Raising.....

I hope you all will indulge me as I post a "blog" I received by e-mail from my daughter Stephanie today. She is recently married and she and her husband are living in Seoul Korea. She is teaching English to Korean middle schoolers.

Somewhere inside me I must have realized that some of my American students would choose a military career. We live in a land that (now) presents all of our kids with that choice for the future. Taking that for granted, I simply put it into the back of my mind. I confess, I never thought before of the armed service my preschoolers might face or the combat training my middle schoolers might experience if they so desired. So, I never asked myself what kind of soldiers I might be creating. Of course, the answer goes hand in hand with what kind of person am I creating, but a couple specific incidents here got me thinking solely in the realm of students as soldiers.

I teach night classes twice a week on my campus. These are English Excellency Classes and the students I engage with are there for conversation and have high abilities. A couple of weeks ago, during a discussion of the first moon landing, we heard the steady drone of boots on concrete—a sound only made famous in my mind by military movies and old reel-to-reel class films in public school. During the first session break, we walked outside to the courtyard to find that an entire troupe of soldiers had, indeed, descended upon our school...in full training fatigues, complete with rifles, helmets, a large screen with a war film playing for propaganda, and several units of equipment for staging battles.

This was not my first encounter with them! A month before I was leaving the office rather late and walked through the pitch black hallways into the slightly less pitch black courtyard only to find myself face to face with a soldier holding a rifle. Freak out! I've come to find out that these military training camps and war games are held monthly on our campus by government order. So for the remainder of the night we heard training drills, footsteps, pop guns, and commands barked out of bullhorns.

You see, living in the States, where military service is not compulsory, I had forgotten all about the potential my students had to serve and protect, to fight and defend. All that night I was reminded of the mandatory 2 years of service for each Korean male. I thought of Alex, a sarcastic, quick-witted 7th grader who has a ready laugh and firm command of English and politics. I saw him and all his friends working a hand-out and realized that one day the pencil in their hands would be replaced with a rifle. During war time or times of peace, it is an intense duty all the same. So I asked myself...what kind of soldiers was I creating?

Just as sediment moved in small pieces from day to day can create or tear away mountains, *so we as teachers, parents, leaders, older siblings, and mentors affect and create the people we encounter.* What kind of soldiers are we raising? Sure, I mean people in and out of service. We are creating in our students and children a desire to fight for and defend something. What will that be? And how will they do it?

I am reminded of a family friend who has many children—I've lost count in fact. When asked why she and her husband chose to have so many and chose to home-school them all her response was simple. She felt created to raise soldiers for the army of God. She is affecting her community for the better by understanding that how she raises her kids matters. Creating a sense of value, fostering their natural talents, supporting their goals...all of these things are the call and should be the joy of parents and teachers.

Confession time: I LOVE Judge Judy. I often watch clips of her on youtube.com and wonder why my own mother doesn't have a TV show too. Judy seems mean, harsh, even berating at times but after years of serving in family court she has seen every mistake and attitude that could come down the pike. She gives the truth. These days people realize how hard the truth can be to hear and they hate it. I hope I love my kids enough to always give them the truth. I hope I have the courage to reel them in even when it hurts. I hope I lack the ego that stirs up hate and disrespect even if that is all a child gives me.

I encourage all of you to question how you are affecting your community of students and children. I know I was lucky to have the teachers, parent, and mentors I received. It wasn't always easy for them, but they were faithful. I pray that we all are faithful in the commitment we have towards serving those in our charge.
